I feel the goals and objectives of the course essay could have been made more clear. The directions and syllabus were fairly vague.

- Test grading could be subjective.

- The videos in class were helpful because seeing the events we discuss adds more dimension to the issues we study.

The instructor was well-educated about the material and motivated me to learn more and applying knowledge into the practical world.

The test format is rather difficult. Given the time allotted, I did not feel I was able to answer all aspects of the question thoroughly. The grading was also too subjective.

She's a good teacher but the material is just kinda boring. Also she needs to make her powerpoint images bigger.

The end of semester background paper could be a little more refined and shorter. The only reason is because it's the only major writing assignment so it's hard to gauge how it will be graded.
